Bookmaking Rates

Personal Books

The following is a rate chart for bookmaking services (for personal books only). Books are sold separately and may be purchased from Lia's Blurb Bookstore at <http://www.blurb.com/user/store/thinklia>. Book Design (for any book format)

\$4/page

Includes cover design, custom book layouts, basic photo editing (i.e., resizing and cropping, sharpening, basic color correction, etc.), and publication of book through Blurb.

For more advanced layouts requiring intensive InDesign or Photoshop work (i.e., collage- and scrapbook-style pages), send an e-mail to info@thinklia.com for a custom quote.

Photo Editing*

\$60/hour

Advanced image editing, including exposure adjustments, object selections, etc. (anything beyond basic crop and color correction).

Content Editing*

\$40/hour

Includes editorial direction in developing book subject, choosing images for the book, writing copy, etc.

*All books are subject to the book design fee of \$4/page. However, photo editing and content editing are additional services. If your custom book requires significant image editing (i.e., advanced color correction, exposure adjustments, etc.), text editing (beyond basic proofing of image captions), and editorial direction (such as image selection and creative writing), the photo and content editing fees will apply.

Here's a tip:

Once you're ready to have your book made, please try to have your materials organized. For example, if you want your photos arranged in a specific order, give the image files clear names (photo1.jpg, photo2.jpg, etc.). Organizing your images (and text) beforehand contributes to the timely production of your custom book.

Bookmaking Pointers

Things to think about before making a book...

- » What kind of book do I want? Photo book, wedding book, blog book, etc.?
- » What book format am I interested in? Size? Hardcover or softcover?
- » How many images do I want to include?
- » How long should the book be?
- » Is there a particular style/theme that I want for my book? Color palettes? Typography?
- » Do I want help with creating a theme or subject for my book?
- » Are all my images print ready? (300 ppi, high resolution, etc.)
- » Are there images that I need to have scanned?
- » Do I need help selecting images for the book? Are my images in order?
- » Is there any text that I want to add? Do I need assistance with writing for my book?
